2.In the light of the same, these Civil Miscellaneous Appeals are dismissed as withdrawn. No Costs.

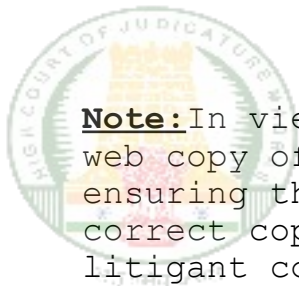
