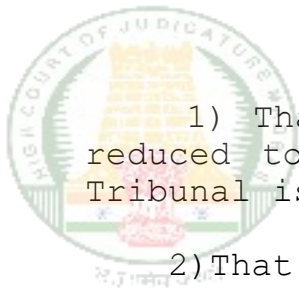
PRAYER :-
