PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.304 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A1, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, for the offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 506(ii) IPC in Crime No.304 of 2021, on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to previous motive, the petitioner and other accused attacked the defacto complaint with wooden log.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in the case. He further submits that it is a case and counter case. Hence, he prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) opposed for grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that the petitioner is involved in eight other cases, out of which, five cases ended in acquittal and three cases are still pending.

5. Considering the nature of offence and also considering the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
