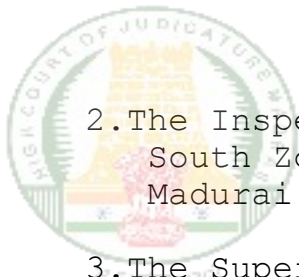

3.Accordingly, these Writ Petitions stand closed. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

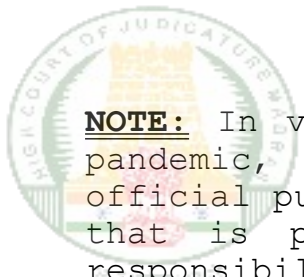
