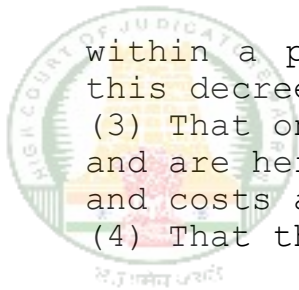
DECREE:-
