PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

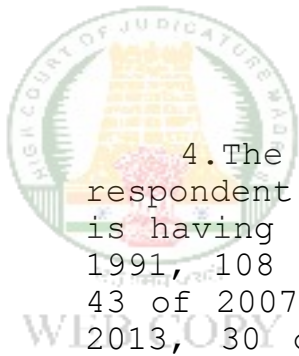
For Anticipatory bail in Crime.No. 137 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/sole accused apprehending arrest for the alleged offence punishable under Section 379 of I.P.C in Crime No.137 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that on 22.05.2021, the driver of the defacto complainant contacted the defacto complainant over phone and informed that some materials, which were used for agricultural work worth about Rs.2,550/-, were missing from the agricultural field. Thereafter, on search, a money purse of the petitioner was recovered from the agriculture field. Therefore, the present case came to be registered against the petitioner.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and he has not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution, but he has been falsely implicated in this case.



4.The learned Government Advocate (crl.side) appearing for the respondent police submits that apart from this case, the petitioner is having fourteen previous cases to his credit in Crime Nos.143 of 1991, 108 of 2002, 01 of 2003, 22 of 2005, 37 of 2006, 27 of 2007, 43 of 2007, 56 of 2008, 57 of 2008, 56 of 2018, 19 of 2018, 182 of 2013, 30 of 2020 and 177 of 2020 on the file of the respondent police.

5. Considering the nature of offences and the antecedents of the petitioner, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
