O R D E R

This petition has been filed to direct the learned III Additional District Sessions Judge (PCR), Madurai , to accept the surrender of the petitioners and consider the bail applications on the date of surrender in connection with Crime No.378 of 2017 on the file of the second respondent Police.

2. The petitioners are arrayed as accused in Crime No.378 of 2017 on the file of the second respondent for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 148, 341, 294(b), 323, 324, 427, 307 of I.P.C and Sections 3(1)(r), 3(1)(s), 3(2)(va), 3(2)(v) of the Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities)



Act, 2015.

3. Mr.R.M.S.Sethuraman, learned Additional Public Prosecutor accepts notice for the respondents 1 and 2. He would submit that the injured have been discharged from the hospital on 30.06.2017 itself.

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4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and oldness of the occurrence, this Court is inclined to pass the following orders only to the petitioners :-

1) The petitioners shall appear before the learned III Additional District Sessions Judge (PCR), Madurai, within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

2) On such surrender along with notice served to the defacto complainant, the concerned Judge shall consider the bail applications filed by the petitioners and pass orders on merits on the same day of their surrender, after hearing the defacto complainant by complying with Section 15(5) of the Act.

5. With the above observation, this Criminal Original Petition is disposed of with regard to the petitioners.
