PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory bail in Crime No.9 of 2021 on the file of the
Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the
respondent Police, for the offence punishable under sections 465,
468, 471 in Crime No.9 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.In earlier occasions, several petitions filed by the
petitioner, seeking anticipatory bail were dismissed on the ground
that two sale agreements have been fabricated and the second
accused, who happens to be a Tahsildar, appears to have acted as a
tout and there are specific overt acts available as against him.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits
that this is the third petition filed by the petitioner for
anticipatory bail. He further submits that the petitioner is ready
to abide by any conditions imposed on him by this Court. Hence, he
prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submits that
the earlier anticipatory bail petitions were dismissed by this Court
on the ground that there is specific overtact against this
petitioner.



5.Today, (30.11.2021), when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate submits that there is no change in circumstances.

6. Considering the nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner, and there is no change in circumstances after the dismissal of earlier petitions, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
