PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No. 865 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police, for the offence punishable under section 379 IPC and Sections 21(4) of Mines and Minerals (Development & Regulation) Act, 1957, in Crime No. 865 of 2021, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner has transported one unit of river sand in lorry without valid permission.

3.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that this is the second petition filed by the petitioner for anticipatory bail. The earlier petition was dismissed by this Court on 08.10.2021. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to abide

by any conditions imposed on him by this Court. Hence, he prayed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) submits that this is the second anticipatory bail petition. The first anticipatory bail petition was dismissed by this Court vide order dated 08.10.2021 in Crl.O.P.(MD)No.15454 of 2021, on the ground eight previous cases are pending against this petitioner.

5. Today, (30.11.2021), when the matter is taken up for hearing, the learned Government Advocate submits that still there are five cases are pending against the petitioner.

6. Considering the nature of allegations levelled against the petitioner, and there is no considerable change in circumstances, after the dismissal of earlier petition, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

7. Accordingly, the Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
