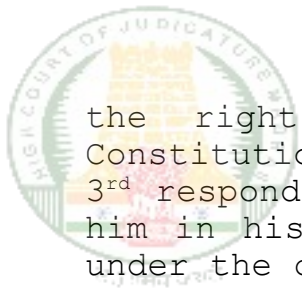

**PRAYER** : Writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India to issue a writ of declaration, declaring that the rule which is referred and relied upon in the impugned order of transfer passed by the 3<sup>rd</sup> respondent in EX NK/I.
