The Civil Revision Petition is allowed, accordingly. No costs.

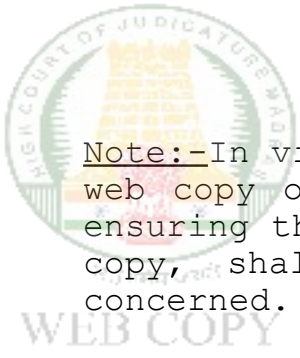
