PRAYER: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus, to call for the records relating to the impugned order in P.R.No.229/07, dated 21.05.2010, passed by the fourth respondent which was modified in C.No.C4/AP.80/2010, dated 14.12.2010, passed by the third respondent which was confirmed by the second respondent in R.C.No.48162/AP 2(1)/2011, dated 18.03.2011, again which was confirmed by the first respondent in G.O.(2D)No.64, dated 23.02.2015 and quash the same and consequently to direct the respondents to provide the arrears of salary to the punishment period and revise the service seniority to the petitioner.

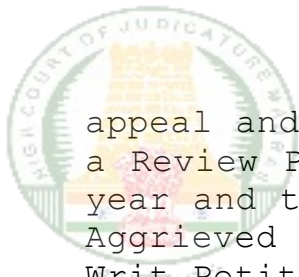

The petitioner was working in the Police Department. Based on the criminal case, a disciplinary proceedings was initiated and he was awarded with a punishment of reduction in time scale of pay by three stages for three years which shall operate to postpone his future increments. Against which the petitioner preferred an



appeal and the punishment was reduced to two years. Subsequently, a Review Petition was filed and the punishment was reduced to one year and the petitioner filed a Mercy Petition which was rejected. Aggrieved over the same, the petitioner has preferred the present Writ Petition.

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2. During the pendency of the Writ Petition, the petitioner has attained superannuation and retired from service. Therefore, the prayer has become infructuous. Recording this statement, the Writ Petition is dismissed as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.
