For R-1	: Mr.T.Senthil Kumar, Additional Public Prosecutor.

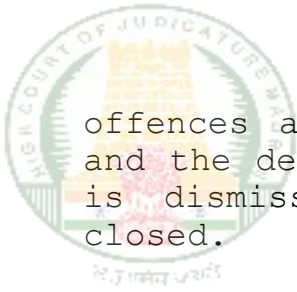
O R D E R
