ORDER

This Court is able to see that the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner was not present on several occasions, despite enough indulgence was shown to the counsel for the petitioner. When the matter was listed on 01.09.2021, there was no representation for the petitioner. Thereafter, the matter was posted on 02.09.2021 and at the request of the learned counsel for the petitioner, the case was adjourned by a week.

2. On 22.09.2021, the writ petition was listed and there was no representation for the petitioner. Hence, this Court directed the matter to be listed on 23.09.2021 under the caption "for dismissal". There was no representation on 23.09.2021. Again, this Court directed the Registry to list the matter on 24.09.2021 under the caption "for dismissal". Even today, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner did not appear. Hence, this Court has no other option, but to dismiss the writ petition for non prosecution. Accordingly, this Writ petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

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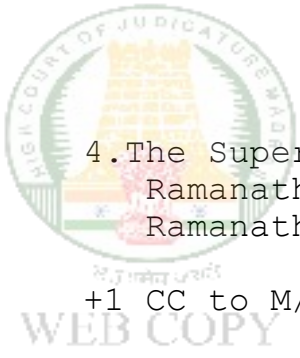
