2. The main allegations were levelled against the first accused Thiru.Narayanan. He has passed away. The allegations against the present petitioners who are shown as A2 & A3 are not that serious. In any event, the defacto complainant Rama Moorthy who has been duly identified by Thiru.L.Ravi Chandran H.C.1040 attached to Emaneshwaram Police Station, Ramanathapuram is present before me and he has no objection for quashing the impugned proceedings. The parties have also filed a joint memo of compromise and the same is taken on record. When the defacto complainant does not wish to



pursue the case, no purpose will be served in keeping the impugned proceedings alive. The impugned proceedings are quashed. This Criminal Original Petition is allowed.
