3. I made it clear that I have not gone into the merits of the matter. With these directions, this writ petition stands disposed of. No costs.

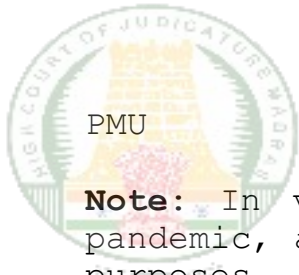
