3. The second respondent is directed to look into the matter and take action as per law. This writ petition stands disposed of accordingly. No costs.

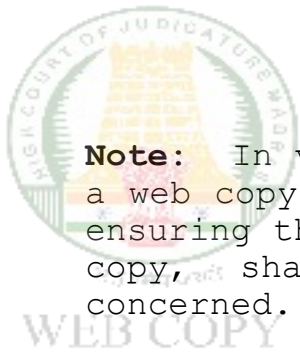
