PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.573 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/A3 who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 353, 352, 448 and 506(ii) of IPC r/w. Section 3(1) of TNPPDL Act, 1984 in Crime No.573 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 07.07.2021 the petitioner along with other accused went to the tasmac shop and asked for bottle. When the defacto complainant asked for money, the petitioner along with other accused said to have abused the defacto complainant, assaulted him and also caused damage to the shop worth about Rs.3360/-. Hence the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and a false case has been foisted against



4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent police would submit that no one sustained injuries in the said occurrence and no previous case is pending against the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts that no one sustained injuries in the said occurrence, that except the offence under Sections 353 and 506 (ii) of IPC and Section 3(1) of TNPPDL Act, all other offences are bailable in nature and also the fact that the petitioner is not having any previous case of similar nature, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Pattukottai, Thanjavur District on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the learned Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhaar card or bank pass book to ensure their identity;

[b] the petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.5,000/- (Rupees Five Thousand only) to the credit of Crime No.573 of 2021 before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Pattukottai, Thanjavur District, within a period of two weeks without prejudice to his rights and contentions before the trial Court;

(c) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of one month and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

(d) the petitioner shall not tamper with the evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(e) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(f) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]***; and;



(g)if the accused/ petitioner thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
