PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL UNDER SEC.438 OF CR.P.C

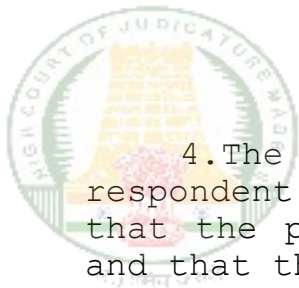
PRAYER :-For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.220 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 279, 353 IPC and 102 of Cr.P.C, in Crime No.220 of 2021, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons drove their car Bolero Pickup bearing registration number TN 30 CZ 2167, in a rash manner and the respondent police had tried to stop the car, but the same was not stopped by the petitioners and deterred the respondent police from discharging their duty. Hence, the present complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and not committed any offence as alleged by the prosecution. The petitioner is not having any previous case. Co-accused were released on bail. Hence, he seeks anticipatory bail



4.The learned Additional Public Prosecutor appearing for the respondent would submit that the investigation is not yet completed, that the petitioner is not having any previous case at his credit and that the co-accused were already released on bail.

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5.Considering the nature of charges levelled against the petitioner and also the facts that the co-accused ie., A1 and A2 were enlarged on bail by this Court and A4 was enlarged on bail by the Sessions Court and that the petitioner is not having any previous case for similar or serious offence, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner, but with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate NO.I, Ramanathapuram on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent Police or to the Police Officer, who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a)the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Magistrate may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(b)the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am for a period of one month and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.

(c)the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(d)the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(e)on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in ***P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]***; and;

(f)if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
