2. This criminal original petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to pursue all the remedies available to her under law.

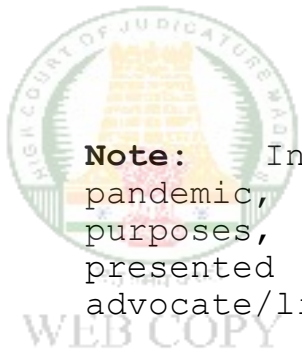
