3. Considering the aforesaid facts, I am not inclined to grant any relief. This Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.

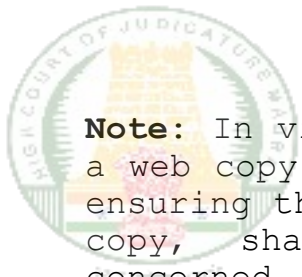
