Petition is disposed of.

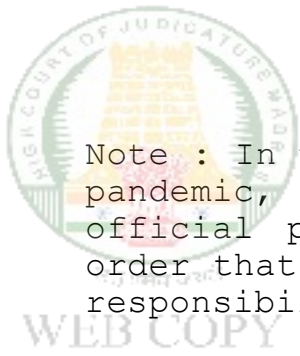
