4.With these observations, this Writ Petition stands disposed of. No costs.

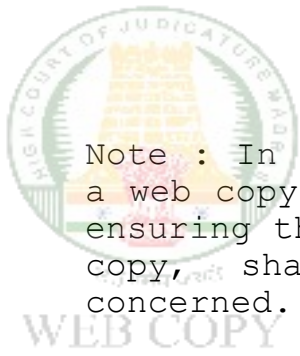
