PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.980 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/Accused, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the offences punishable under Sections 147, 294(b), 323, 427, 355, 506(i) & 379(NP) IPC, in Crime No.980 of 2021, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners had abused and assaulted the *defacto* complainant. Hence, the complaint.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that a false case has been foisted against the petitioners, as the petitioners had caused damages to the tune of Rs.6,000/- (Rupees Six



Thousand Only), case in counter was registered in Crime No.981 of 2021 against the defacto complainant and party and that the injured was discharged from the hospital. Hence, prays to release them on anticipatory bail.

4.The learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side) appearing for the respondent would submit that based upon the complaint given by the defacto complainant, this case has been registered and based upon the complaint given by the first petitioner, case in counter was registered in Cr.No.981 of 2021 for the offences under SectionS 147, 294(b), 323, 506(i) IPC and Section 4 of Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act and the date of occurrence in both the FIRs stated as 02.12.2021 and both sides got injured and in this case injured was discharged from the hospital.

5.Reading of the FIR shows that there was dispute arose between the parties when the accused persons failed to execute the same as promised and based on that dispute was arose between them. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case, that the injured was discharged from the hospital, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners with certain conditions.

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or their appearance, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Madurai and on their executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties, each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and the petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 am for a period of one month and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation. The petitioners shall comply with the conditions stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7.The petitioners shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of fifteen days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
