When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that after the investigation, the closure report has been submitted before the Judicial Magistrate, Pattukottai, finding that it was mistake of fact and it was filed before the concerned Court on 09.12.2018 and



notice was also served upon the petitioner. He would also submit that he also filed the protest petition before the concerned Court. The petitioner can work out the remedy in the aforesaid proceedings. So, nothing survives for consideration for direction in this petition.
