PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :-

For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.516 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioner/Accused No.1, apprehending arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 294(b), 448, 506(i) IPC and Section 4 of TN Prohibition of Harassment of Women Act, 2002 in Crime No.516 of 2021 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner with a motive tress passed into the defacto complainant's house and abused her and try to attack her. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he has been falsely implicated in this case. The petitioner and the defacto complainant are living together. Due some misunderstanding trouble arose between them.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. Side) for the respondent police submitted that on previous occasion a complaint has been received against the petitioner and he was warned.

5. Even though some of the facts has been argued by the petitioner and as well as the Government Advocate (Crl. Side), this Court is inclined to consider the same at this stage and it is a matter of trial. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the



petitioner.

6. Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, before the learned Judge, Additional Mahila Court, Madurai on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judge concerned and the petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. until further orders. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. scrupulously.

7. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
