2. Recording the said submission, this writ petition is dismissed as infructuous. No Costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petitions are closed.

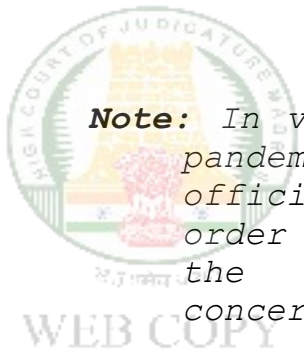
