(Ms) No. 146, Transport (C) Department, dated 30.11.2015, by redesignating the petitioners as Selection Grade Superintendents, so as to enable them to receive the Selection Grade Superintendents' time scale of pay of Rs. 7500-250-12500 with effect from 01.01.2008 and the revised scale of pay (as per 6th pay commission) of Rs. 9300-34800 + Grade Pay Rs. 4900 with effect from 17.06.2009 and to revise the pension and retirement benefits and to pay the consequential and monetary benefits with effect from 01.04.2015.

These writ petitions have been filed for a direction to the respondents to implement the G.O.(Ms)No.146, Transport (C) Department, dated 30.11.2015, by redesignating the petitioners as Selection Grade Superintendents, so as to enable them to receive the Selection Grade Superintendents' time scale of pay of Rs.7500-250-12500 with effect from 01.01.2008 and the revised scale of pay of Rs.9300-34800 + Grade Pay Rs.4900 with effect from 17.06.2009.
