Prayer :-

Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, to issue a Writ of Mandamus directing the respondents 3 & 4 to hand over the temple tank situated in SF.No.170/2 to an extent of 1 Acre, Vengur Village Panchayat, Thiruvarumbur Taluk, Trichy District to Sri Ayyanar Sambugamoorthi Temple, Vengur Village Panchayat, Trichy District and further directing the respondents 1 & 2 to take appropriate action against the 4th respondent for unjust enrichment and misuse of temple tank by auctioning fishery rights to private individuals and to recover the amount collected through auctioning of fisheries right of the temple tank from the fourth respondent on the basis of the representation of the petitioner dt.3.1.2016., within a time frame fixed by this Court.
