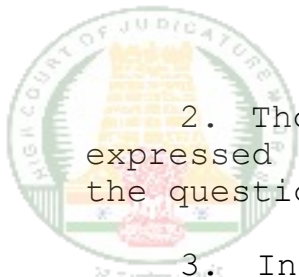

Learned counsel submits that the captioned writ petition being a challenge to appointment of an Executive Officer under the Tamil Nadu Religious and Charitable Endowments Act, 1959 (Tamil Nadu Act 22 of 1959) has become infructuous owing to the demise of the writ petitioner.
