However, if there is any grievance with regard to the payment of subsistence allowance, the petitioner is at liberty to work out her remedy in the manner known to law.

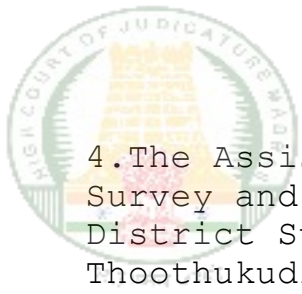
