PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec.438 of Cr.P.C

PRAYER :- For Anticipatory Bail in Crime No.512 of 2021 on the file of the Respondent Police.

ORDER : The Court made the following order :-

The petitioners/Accused Nos.1 and 2, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b) and 506(ii) of IPC in Crime No.512 of 2021, seek anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that due to previous motive, the petitioners abused the defacto complainant in filthy language and attacked him with aruval and caused injuries to him. Hence, the case was registered against the petitioners.

3.The learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.The learned Government Advocate(Crl.side) appearing for the respondent police would submit that apart from this case, the petitioners are having two previous cases to their credit.



5.Considering the nature of the offence and also considering the bad antecedents of the petitioners, this Court is not inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6.Accordingly, this Criminal Original Petition is dismissed.
