The Advocate Commissioner shall be paid a sum of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty Thousand Only) towards the remuneration, equally by the revision petitioner/plaintiff as well as the respondents 4 to 8 forthwith. Apart from that they also arrange for the conveyance and other incidental expenses of the Advocate Commissioner.
