2. Recording the aforesaid, this Writ Petition is closed. No costs.

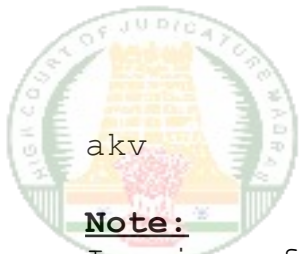
