PRAYER : Criminal Original Petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C, to direct the second respondent to provide police protection to remove the damaged electric pole due to low-lying electric line from the petitioner's land in S.No.21/2 to the extent of 2562 sq ft at Unjampatti Village, Theni District on the basis of the petitioner's representation dated 08.11.2019.
