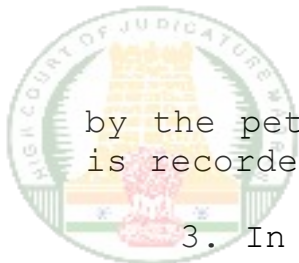

ORDER

The Criminal Revision Case is directed against the Judgment of conviction passed in Crl.A.No.45 of 2016, dated 20.06.2017 on the file of the learned Additional District Sessions Judge, Palani, Dindigul District, confirming the Judgment of conviction dated 05.10.2016 passed in S.T.C.No.223 of 2016 on the file of the learned Judicial Magistrate (Fast Track Court) Palani.

2. Today (01.04.2021), when the matter is taken for hearing, the revision petitioner has filed an application under Section 147 of the Negotiable Instruments Act along with affidavit of the respondent / complainant and the joint memo of both the parties, whereunder the respondent / complainant has received a sum of Rs.75,00,000/- towards full and final settlement of the claim due



by the petitioner / accused. The joint memo filed by both parties is recorded.

3. In view of the compromise entered into between the parties, the offence under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act stands compounded under Section 147 of the Negotiable Instruments Act. Consequently, the Criminal Revision Case is allowed and the judgments of the trial Court and the Appellate Court are set aside and the accused is acquitted from the charges levelled against him. Bail bond if any, executed by the accused shall stand discharged. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is disposed of.
