2. In view of the above, these Civil Revision Petitions are dismissed as withdrawn. No costs. Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.

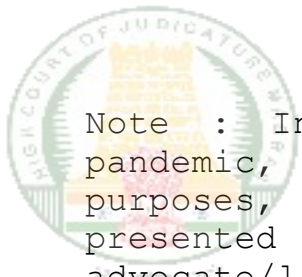
