2.Heard the learned counsel appearing for the petitioners.

When the matter is taken up for hearing today, the learned Government Advocate appearing for the respondents submitted that for the very same issue, the proposal sent by the second respondent on 17.04.2017 was considered and rejected by the first respondent, by proceedings in Letter No.14252/AA1/2017-1, dated 08.05.2017. In view of the same, the petitioners are not entitled for the relief now claimed in the Writ Petitions.

4. In view of the rival submissions made by the learned counsel appearing on either side, without deciding the issue on merits, it is suffice to direct the respondents to consider the representations of the petitioners, dated 19.07.2017, 13.11.2019 and 18.11.2019 respectively and pass appropriate orders on merits and in accordance with law within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

5. With the above direction, these Writ Petitions are disposed of. No costs.
