The matter has become infructuous. Hence, these Writ Petitions are dismissed as infructuous. No costs. Consequently, connected miscellaneous petition is closed.

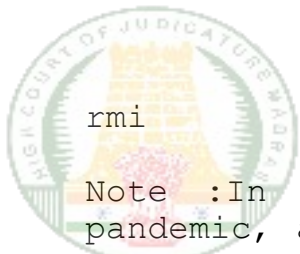
