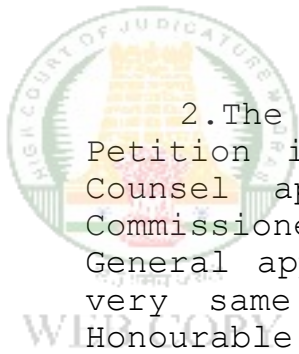

The petitioner appearing in person has filed the above Writ Petition as a "Public Interest Litigation" to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the first respondent to issue fresh Corporation and Municipality Election notification within fifteen days.



2.The Writ Petition was filed in the year 2019. When the Writ Petition is taken up for hearing today, Mr.B.Saravanan, learned Counsel appearing for the first respondent/The State Election Commissioner and Mr.Veerakathiravan, learned Additional Advocate General appearing for the second respondent submitted that for the very same relief, a Writ Petition has been filed before the Honourable Supreme Court of India and the Honourable Apex Court, by its order, dated 28.09.2021, granted four months time to the respondents to conduct the Local Body Election to the Corporation and Municipality.

3.Since, the Honourable Apex Court had already granted four months time to the respondents to conduct the election, no further direction need be issued to the respondents.

4.In such view of the matter, the Writ Petition stands closed. No costs.Consequently, connected Miscellaneous Petition is closed.
