PRAYER: Contempt Petition filed under Section 11 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, praying this Court to punish the Contemnors/Respondents for wilfully disobeying and not complying with the order of this Court made in W.P(MD)No.6243 of 2016, dated 30.3.2016.

PRAYER IN W.P(MD)No.6243 of 2016: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying this Court to issue a Writ of Mandamus, directing the 1st respondent to pay the petitioner Rs.3,33,877/- towards Gratuity and Rs.2,23,632/- towards leave salary and also arrears of wages for the period from 01.09.2013 to 31.01.2015 payable pursuant new wage settlement together with 18% interest per annum and further directing the respondents to pay him Rs.1,51,582/- towards the pension commutation amount and arrears of pension for the period from 01.02.2015 by revising his pension together with 18% interest per annum, after calculating all his terminal / pension benefits based on the monthly wages payable to him on the month of his retirement I.e., January 2015 by revision the same as per the settlement dated 13.04.2015, as ordered by the Division Bench of this Court in its order dated 29.01.2016 in W.A.(MD).no.1457/2015 etc. batch.

Alleging that the order of this Court made in W.P(MD)No.6243 of 2016, dated 30.03.2016 has not been complied with, the Petitioner has come up with the present Contempt Petition.

4.As already liberty is given to the Petitioner in paragraph 6 of the order passed in the above Writ Petition, it is open to him to work out the remedy in the manner known to law.

5.With the above observation, the Contempt Petition stands closed.
