Prayer in WP(MD). 7530 of 2016 :

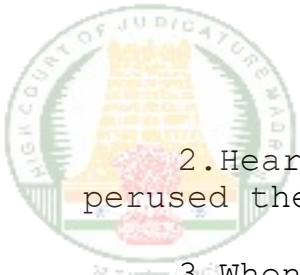

However, the learned counsel for the Petitioner disputes the Calculation memo submitted by the learned counsel for the Contemnor.

4. As already liberty is given to the Petitioner in paragraph 6 of the order passed in the above Writ Petition, it is open to him to work out the remedy in the manner known to law.

5. With the above observation, the Contempt Petition stands closed.
