4. Recording the submission made by learned Government Advocate (Crl.Side), this Writ Petition stands dismissed for non-prosecution. No costs.

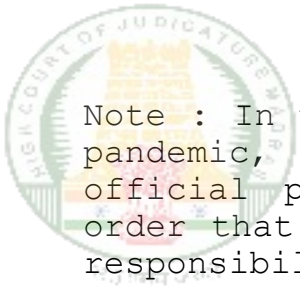
