Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue a writ, direction or an order more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus by invoking Article 226 of Constitution of India declaring the action of the Respondents in not considering the representation of the Petitioners Dated 14.5.2018 and thereafter also seeking enhancement of the compensation issued to them on acquiring the petitioners agricultural land by resuming the Assigned lands allotted to the petitioners Years back for establishing the Hyderabad Green Pharma without giving them the fair compensation compared to the other adjacent Villager farmers lands where two lakhs more money than what is given to the petitioners and also without there being proper Survey of lands under occupation of the family members of the Petitioners thereby denying proper computation of the land is illegal unlawful and against constitution Articles 14, 21 and 300-A apart from in total violation The Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013 consequently direct the Respondents to enhance and disburse the compensation amount to the petitioners on par with their adjacent Kandukuru Mandal Utlapalli Villagers where 10 lakhs is given as compensation and also direct to the Respondent

to Compute the Compensation as per the Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013 and pay the difference amount also, further direct the Respondents to determine the actual lands under the occupation of the Petitioners and their family members possession by conducting a Re-Survey by the 6th Respondent Assistant Director of Survey Department into the Acquired lands for the Hyderabad Green Pharma by the Respondents and thereby do justice to the Petitioners.
