Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to quash the First Information Report having crime No 224/2021 dated 24.03.2021 of P.S Madipally, Cyberabad District as against the petitioners.

Petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C praying that in the circumstances stated in the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to stay all further proceedings including arrest of the petitioner in FIR No. 224 of 2021 of P.S Madipally, Cyberabad District.

This Petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Memorandum of Grounds of Criminal Petition and upon hearing the arguments of Sri KRUPADANAM KOLA, Advocate for the Petitioners and of the Public Prosecutor on behalf of the Respondent No.1.

The Court made the following: ORDER

CRIMINAL PETITION No.3793 OF 2021

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. to quash the proceedings in Crime No.224 of 2021 pending on the file of Medipally Police Station, Rachakonda District. The petitioners herein are Accused Nos.1, 2 and 4 in the said crime. The offences alleged against them are under Sections 498-A, 323 IPC and Sections 3 and 4 of Dowry Prohibition Act, 1961.

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners and the learned Public Prosecutor.

Perused the record.

A perusal of the complaint dated 24.03.2021 would reveal that the marriage of the first petitioner with second respondent was performed three and half years ago. Thereafter, it appears that there are matrimonial disputes arose between them. First petitioner is husband of the second respondent, second petitioner is mother and the third petitioner is sister of first accused. It appears that there are strained relations between the first petitioner and the second respondent.

Considering the above said facts and also the fact that the punishment for the offences alleged against the petitioners is seven years or below seven years, this Criminal Petition is disposed of directing the Investigating Officer in Crime No.224 of 2021 pending on the file of Medipally Police Station, Rachakonda District, to strictly follow the procedure laid down under Section 41-A of Cr.P.C. and also the guidelines issued by the Hon'ble Apex Court in a decision reported

in **ARNESH KUMAR V/s. STATE OF BIHAR**¹. However, it is made clear that the petitioners shall cooperate with the Investigating Officer in concluding the investigation.

Miscellaneous Petitions, pending if any, shall stand closed.
