Petition under Section 438 of Cr.P.C, praying that in the circumstances stated in the grounds filed in support of the Criminal Petition, the High Court may be pleased to grant anticipatory bail to the Petitioners/Accused Nos.1 and 2 by directing the S.H.O., P.S, Anthargoa Ramagundam Commissionerate, Peddapally District or any arresting officer to enlarge them on bail in the event of their arrest in connection with Crime No.50 of 2021, of P.S, Anthargoan, Ramagundam commissionerate, Peddapally District.

The petition coming on for hearing, upon perusing the Petition and the grounds filed in support thereof and upon hearing the arguments of M/s K. VENUMADHAV Advocate for the Petitioners and of Assistant PUBLIC PROSECUTOR for the Respondent, the Court made the following.

ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (Cr.P.C.), is filed by the petitioners/A-1 and A-2, for grant of anticipatory bail in Crime No.50 of 2021 of P.S. Anthargoan, Ramagundam, registered for the offence punishable under Section 306 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC).

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners/A-1 and A-2, the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor representing the respondent-State and perused the record.

Learned counsel for the petitioners/A-1 and A-2 would submit that the petitioners are innocent persons and never committed any offence as alleged by the respondent-police. It is further submitted that the petitioners are law-abiding citizens and have nothing to do with the alleged offence. Further, they are ready to give sufficient sureties to the satisfaction of this Court to secure their presence on each and every date of hearing to face the trial and also ready to abide by the terms and conditions if any that may be imposed by this Court for their release. Hence, he prayed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners/A-1 and A-2.

Learned Assistant Public Prosecutor representing the respondent-State opposed to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners/A-1 and A-2.

As seen from the material papers available on record, particularly the suicidal note, the deceased has stated nothing about the present petitioners and rather requested his father to help the petitioners for repayment of loans to the borrowers.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners/A-1 and A-2 on some conditions.

Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is allowed and the petitioners/A-1 and A-2 are granted anticipatory bail subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (1) The petitioners/A-1 and A-2 are directed to surrender before the Station House Officer, P.S. Anthargoan, Ramagundam, within a period of 15 days from the date of this order. On such surrender, the said Station House Officer shall release the petitioners/A-1 and A-2 on bail, on their executing personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand only) each with two sureties for a like sum each to his satisfaction.
- (2) The petitioners/A-1 and A-2 shall appear before the investigating authorities as and when required by them for the purpose of fair investigation.

(3) The petitioners/A-1 and A-2 shall abide by the conditions stipulated in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and co-operate with the investigating officer in investigating the case.

Miscellaneous applications, if any, pending shall stand closed.
