ORDER:

Learned Public Prosecutor placed on record a letter dated 13.07.2021 in respect of the case details of the subject matter and the same is made as part of the record.

From a perusal of the same, it is revealed that the Police have completed investigation in the subject crime, filed charge sheet and CC number is awaited. In view of the same, the subject matter in the Criminal Petition has become infructuous.

Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, liberty is given to the petitioners to file a fresh petition challenging the charge sheet, if so advised. Miscellaneous petitions, if any, pending in this Criminal Petition, shall stand closed.
