Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to issue an appropriate writ, order or direction more particularly one in the nature of Writ of Mandamus declaring the action of the respondents particularly the 3rd respondent in harassing the petitioners falsely without any basis except alleging that the son of petitioner nos 1 to 2 and brother of the 3rd petitioner viz., Mr. Andella Ravi Chandra Yadav involved in some criminal cases and calling them to the police station as illegal arbitrary unjust against the principles of natural justice and against the Constitutional Guarantees and consequently direct the 3rd respondent not to interfere with the peaceful life and liberty of the Petitioners and not to harass the petitioners without following due process of law and to pass

ORDER

Sri S.Rama Mohan Rao, learned Assistant Government Pleader for Home, on instructions, would submit that the respondents Police have registered a case in Crime No.21 of 2021 for the offences under Sections 406, 420 IPC and Section 5 of Telangana Protection of Depositors of Financial Establishments Act, 1999 against the son of first and second petitioners and brother of first petitioner and third petitioner is also an accused in the said crime. The Investigating Officer is investigating into the said crime. Total fraud involved in the said crime is Rupees eight crores. Except investigation, the Police never harassed the first and second petitioners herein.

Considering the above said facts, recording the submission of the learned Assistant Government Pleader for Revenue and also considering the age of first and second petitioners, parents of third petitioner and Andella Ravi Chandra, who is also an accused in the above said crime, this writ petition is disposed of directing the respondents-Police not to harass first and second petitioners herein under the guise of investigation in Crime No.20 of 2021. However, liberty is granted to the respondents-Police to investigate into the said crime against the third petitioner herein as well as the said Andella Ravi Chandra, in accordance with law. No costs.

Miscellaneous Petitions, pending if any, shall also stand closed in the light of this final order.
