Petition under Section 151 of CPC praying that in the circumstances stated in the affidavit filed therewith, the High Court may be pleased to direct the respondent to pay or to deposit a sum of Rs. 32,16,000/- towards rent accrued till 31-8-2010 and continue to pay or deposit future rents till the respondent surrenders vacant possession of the suit schedule property covered under OS No. 371 of 2010 on the file of the III Additional Chief Judge, City Civil Court, Hyderabad, and also direct the respondent to deposit a sum of Rs. 2,80,000/- in respect of the tenancy covered under licence agreement dt. 6-9-2008 and continue to deposit Rs. 10,000/- per month till the surrender of the same, pending disposal of the above CRP.
