ORDER:

This Criminal Petition, under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, is filed by the petitioners/A1, A4 and A5 seeking to quash the proceedings against them in Crime No.776 of 2020 of Jeedimetla Police Station, Cyberabad, registered for the offences punishable under Sections 324 and 307 read with 34 of I.P.C.

2. Heard. Perused the record.
3. On written instructions, dated 01.09.2021, learned Assistant Public Prosecutor would submit that in the subject case, investigation is completed, charge sheet is filed before the XXI Metropolitan Magistrate, Medchal, and P.R.C.No.37 of 2021 is also assigned.
4. Under these circumstances, nothing survives for adjudication in this Criminal Petition.
5. Accordingly, the Criminal Petition is dismissed as infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioners/A1, A4 and A5 to work out the remedies available under law.
